

Bolivia Door-to-Door Passive Optical Network OSFP

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OSFP is a high-speed, high-density, hot-pluggable transceiver module used in data communication applications, targeting speeds of 400G, 800G, and even 1.6TB.

A passive optical network (PON) is a fiber-optic telecommunications network that uses only unpowered devices to carry signals, as opposed to electronic equipment.

Among the different optical standards that enable 400G, the OSFP 400G DR4 stands out for its parallel single-mode architecture, moderate reach, and high density.

OSFP is as backward compatible with QSFP+/QSFP28 as QSFP-DD, but requires an additional OSFP to QSFP adapter. Since the OSFP is slightly wider and deeper than the QSFP, it is possible to build ...

All are common within the OSFP module and all module voltages are referenced to this potential unless otherwise noted. Connect these directly to the host board signal-common ground plane.
