

Connect two switches using single-mode fiber optic cable

SFP transceiver modules are specific to the type of fiber being connected (either single mode or multimode). Choose an SFP module based on the fiber optic cabling that will be connected to the ...

Connecting two media converters back to back via a small switch would work (I'd seriously recommend a small SFP switch though). Creating a chain instead of a ring removes the need for STP.
