

Cut each wire with one clean cut - eliminating any grinding or touch-up. Cut the bottom wires first, in order as shown, from the underside of the tray. Rest the lower jaw of the cutters against the cradle ...

Cut the bottom wires first, in order as shown, from the underside of the tray. Rest the lower jaw of the cutters against the cradle wire and cut at an angle away from the new end. Cut the side wires next, ...

Cut wires with B-Line Angular Bolt Cutter, bend to create a bend, tee, or reducer. Do not use center cut blades. For the best results, use a WB30BC Angular Blade Offset Bolt Cutter with 24" (600 mm) long ...
