Use Code P for correction IRS distribution under section 408 (d) (4). Also you can use code P for any excess deferrals, excess contributions, and excess aggregate contributions taxable in the current year.

Distribution codes in Box 7 of Form 1099-R tell the IRS what type of distribution you received. These codes indicate if the distribution is subject to early withdrawal penalties, exempt from ...

This chart clearly identifies the distribution codes for Box 7 of form 1099-R, which helps note the type of distribution you received, and what they all mean.

A code P on a 2019 1099-R means it was a 2018 excess returned in 2019. The excess must be reported as returned wages on an amended 2018 tax return.

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
