

## Do park electrical distribution boxes need to be fenced off

They're vital for your electricity, but they need space to work safely. Fences, shrubs and trees planted too close can delay power restoration during outages and make routine maintenance ...

Crews need this space to use an eight-foot-long "hot stick" to disconnect the power source on energized padmounts. Other clearances are necessary to perform other repairs. Fences, shrubs ...

There are specific rules and safety guidelines that dictate the required distance between yard fences and various types of electrical boxes, including power meter boxes, transformer boxes, ...

United Power crews also need safe access for repairs and maintenance. Barriers, such as landscaping and fencing, should be kept clear of electrical equipment.

Outdoor electrical equipment shall be installed in suitable enclosures and shall be protected from accidental contact by unauthorized personnel, or by vehicular traffic, or by accidental ...

Generally, no, you cannot place a yard fence directly next to a power box due to safety regulations and the need for unimpeded access by utility companies. Fencing your yard is a great ...
