

Does Norway divide its range into 100m and 1000m

Short it may be, but with that short width, and the towering mountains around it going over 1000m, those two kilometres are possibly the most breathtaking two in all of Norway.

In addition to its mountains and valleys, Norway is also home to vast plains that stretch across much of the country. These plains are characterized by their rolling hills, fertile farmland, and expansive forests.

The dimensions and weights in Norway are very similar to other European countries. The abbreviations are very specific. But see for yourself.

From the southernmost point a swelling complex of ranges, collectively called Lang Mountains, runs northward to divide eastern Norway, or *Østlandet*, from western Norway, or *Vestlandet*.
