

Fiber Optic Cable Steel Hoop Fixing Method

5.5.4 Fix fiber cable to the fixing seat, press it with the pressboard. While diameter is small, enlarge the diameter with insulation tape at the fixing position of fixing seat.

Key steps include preparing the site and cables, inserting the cables into ports on the closure, splicing and storing the fibers, sealing the closure, and installing it via pole mounting or wall mounting.
