Any non-combustible surfaces that are broken or incomplete must be repaired so there's a maximum 1/4 inch gap at the edge of a cabinet or cutout box employing a flush-type cover. Conductors must enter ...

The box on the left cannot be recessed more than 1/8 inch. The box on the right must be flush or have an extension ring installed to ensure that there are no exposed combustible materials behind the ...
