

How to disconnect the network using a switch

Perhaps you're troubleshooting network issues, switching to Wi-Fi, or ensuring security by disconnecting from a wired network. Whatever the reason, knowing how to disable Ethernet on ...

Depending on the situation, simply turning off connectivity from software may work, but the only sure way to get offline is to turn off your modem/router/switch, or physically unplug the Ethernet cable.

The quickest way is to just turn your router/modem off. Rather than mess with the switch settings. Or system settings, internet settings, select your connection and delete it. Then re-input your WiFi when ...

To disconnect from Wi-Fi on your Nintendo Switch and play offline, follow these steps: Open System Settings: From the HOME Menu, select System Settings. Navigate to Internet Settings: ...

I show you how log off or disconnect (aka Forget Network) the wifi internet connection on the Nintendo Switch or Switch Lite. Hope this helps.
