The pigtails are initially hard to plug in and to later remove from the control box but seems to get a bit easier to remove after a few ins and outs in my experience.

I would dig around the cable on the exterior side with a knife or pliers to free up the cable. On the interior side, you can see the rubber grommet so you can cut or pull that off.
