In order to prevent sagging or slipping, the optical cable must be firmly fixed on the upper, lower and middle of the channel of each floor. Usually, nylon cable ties or steel clips can be used for ...

Inspect all equipment (ladders, cable stands, etc.) for defects before using. Repair or replace equipment if it is found in a deteriorated or unsafe condition. Personnel normally should not remain in an area ...

Use cable ties (A) to secure the cable to the cable tray or rack (or to larger, stationary cables when present), every 24 - 36 in (60 - 90 cm). CAUTION: Do NOT tighten the cable ties to the point they ...

This test method applies to all types of indoor cables for indoor application when it is necessary to consider the friction between cables or between cables and ducts.

Although most fiber optic cables are not conductive, any metallic hardware used in fiber optic cabling systems (such as wall-mounted termination boxes, racks, and patch panels) must be grounded.
