

# Reserved length for fiber optic cable laying

Fiber optic cable sequential numbers are required at each pole location and vault wall. Sequential numbers will identify conduit length, and slack left in vaults and at poles.

In order to ensure the safety of the optical cable, the reserved optical cable should be left in the man (hand) hole of the communication pipeline as much as possible.

Some key considerations for installing optical fiber cable are highlighted below. Failure to follow these guidelines may result in damage or attenuation increases of the optical fiber or cable.

Outside plant cables often span distances longer than the limits of manufactured cables (5-15 km typically), Deploying cables of lengths  $>5$ km can be difficult, so cables may need to be spliced to ...
