

Techniques for peeling and welding pigtail sheath

Once the 14 Fr peel-away sheath is in place, assess distal limb patency using angiography, distal pulse palpation, ultrasound, or infrared tissue oximetry. If there is poor limb perfusion, consider placement ...

Identify and mark the skin site overlaying the collecting system. Anesthetize the marked site. Use the peel away plastic sheath provided with the catheter to straighten the pigtail of the catheter.

Check peel-away sheath placement by holding sheath in place, twist dilator hub counterclockwise to release dilator hub from sheath hub, withdraw guidewire and dilator sufficiently to allow blood flow.

Peel-Away™ Straightener Catheters with pigtail shaped or similar configurations are supplied with Peel-Away straighteners to be used as follows. Fig. 1

Peel-away sheaths are a special type of sheath used to introduce a tube or catheter (e.g. tunneled line or gastrostomy tube), which are split in half allowing them to be removed while the tube or catheter ...

The Wire TRUST technique requires a minimum 10-F sheath to accommodate simultaneous insertion of a 4-F pigtail and a 6-F snare catheter. In contrast, the WIPER TRUST ...

Before introducing the Peel-Away® sheath needle into the vessel, secure the sheath to prevent it from advancing prematurely. This can be done by holding it at the base of the sheath.

When the catheter or other device is properly located, peel the sheath away from the device by using the ends of the sheath as handles and pulling them so that the sheath separates longitudinally and ...
